**Details:**

**Eligible students:** 2nd- and 3rd-year undergraduate students majoring in Construction, Electrical & Electronics, Mechanical Engineering, Information Technology, or Economics.

**Requirements:** TOPIK Level 3 or higher, and a GPA of 7/10 or above at UTT.

**Maintenance Requirements:** Maintain a GPA of 3.5/4.5 or above during studies at KNUT and participate in the mentor-mentee program.

**Number of Students:** 10 students.

**Study period at KNUT:** Final two academic years.

**Coverage:**

The total amount of support is approximately VND 218 million per year (equivalent to about KRW 12 million), including tuition, university promotional activity support, and

living expenses. This support program is funded by the Ministry of Education, Republic of Korea, under the Glocal University 30 Project (November 2023 - February 2028).

**Application deadline:** June 30, 2026.

We kindly request UTT's support in nominating qualified candidates who meet the above criteria. The list of nominated students and required documents should be submitted to K-Transportation International Education Center by the stated deadline.

We look forward to welcoming UTT students to our university and further strengthening the partnership between our two institutions.
